Drake continues to hit coaching milestones

For a coach who is in his 44th year of guiding high school soccer players, Vince Drake has seen and experienced just about everything. He's enjoyed tremendous success including 19 trips to a state championship game and 12 victories in those 19 games. There have also been some rough times, though. There have been disappointments, agonizing defeats and frustrating setbacks, including losses in his team's last six state title game appearances with the boys and girls at Trinity.

"The first loss for the boys against Duchesne when we had a goal called back with 10 seconds left in the game really stands out as frustrating," said Drake. "Then in '05 I thought we outplayed Priory but we lost and in '08 we had to play with 10 players for most of the game because we had a player ejected. Those are all what-if situations but just getting that far that many times is quite an accomplishment for the kids."

Drake will have many accomplishments to be proud of when he looks back at his career. During the span of seven months from May-November this year, the 65 year old Mercy High School graduate recorded his 1,000 high school soccer coaching victory overall coaching boys and girls, reached the 700 victory plateau in boys soccer and took the 2011 Trinity boys team to the Missouri Class 2 state championship game.

"The milestones are nice but they are more for the fans and players," said Drake, currently the winningest high school soccer coach in the country. "For me it's not about the victories or the state championships. It's about getting exposure for the players and maybe getting them a chance to play soccer at the next level and maybe getting them some money to pay for college. The wins and the honors are nice, but I don't think a lot about them."

Drake recorded his 1,000 overall victory in a Trinity girls win last May over John Burroughs. Then in October, the Trinity

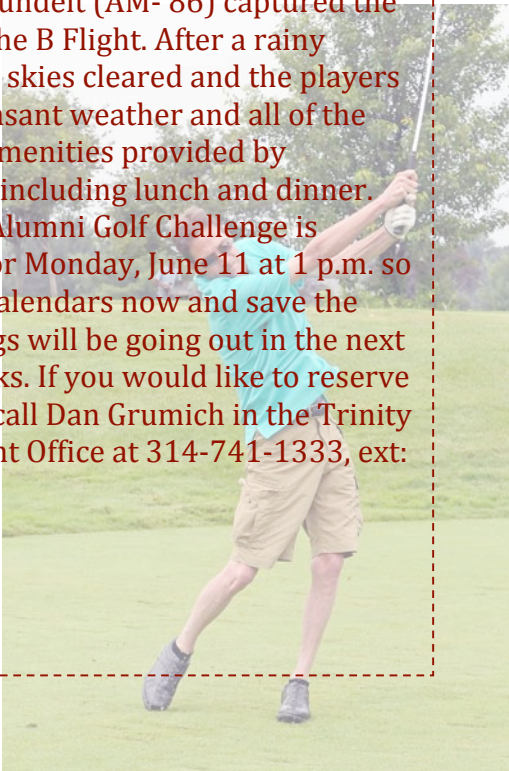
Titan Alumni Players prepare for *Godspell*

All of the teachers in the program were also nominated and specially selected for the program.

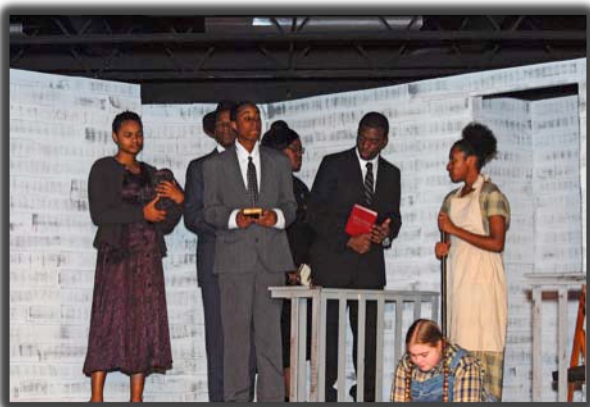

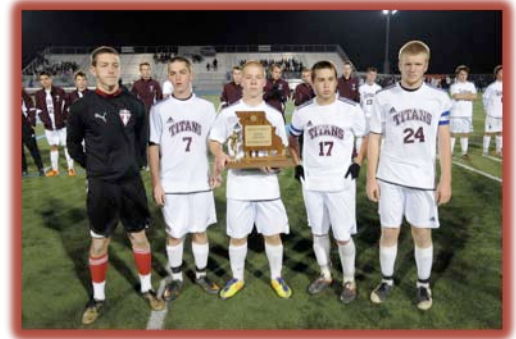

boys team knocked off Lindbergh in the CYC Tournament to notch Drake's 700th win in boys soccer. The Titans boys team eventually advanced to the state final four where they knocked off Smithville 1-0 Nov. 18 before dropping a 2-0 decision to Priory in the state final a day later.

"In terms of team chemistry this was the best group I've had at Trinity," said Drake. Overall this was one of my better teams when it came to team chemistry and senior leadership. Five of my seniors are in the top 20% of their class academically. That makes a difference when it comes to leadership."

Drake knows a little something about team chemistry and the powerful force it can be. He has coached and played, soccer at the highest levels. At St. Louis University Drake played on a pair of National Championship teams. After college, he began coaching at St. Thomas Aquinas where he won two state titles. Following the merger of Aquinas and Mercy, Drake won nine state championships as the boys coach at Aquinas-Mercy and one as the girls coach.

Many of his former players attended a special soccer alumni night September 29 when players from Aquinas, Aquinas-Mercy and Rosary were invited to a Titans' game and the players and Drake were honored at halftime. The state championship teams, their coaches and players from Rosary, Aquinas and Aquinas-Mercy were also recognized.

"That was a very special night. Not only to see all the former Aquinas players come back but to also to see Rosary represented," said Drake. "It was nice that all the former coaches came back too."

In addition to Drake, Fr. (James) Gahan, Joe Morgan, John Mohrmann, a 1978 Aquinas grad, and Paul Stoecklin, a 1982 Aquinas grad, were in attendance. All were head coaches or assistant coaches on state championships teams at Rosary and Stoecklin, currently the Athletic Director at Visitation Academy, was also an assistant coach under Drake at Trinity.

"We want to build on that night for next year and get even more former players out, added Drake.
